## (TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025

**BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN** (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') being the highway authority for the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order and shown hatched red on the attached plan TSL-045, is satisfied that the traffic in the said length of road should be regulated because works are being executed on or near the road.


The Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 **HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:** 

- 1. The Order shall be cited as **BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN Wellington Road To A41**, **Newport (TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025**
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on 5/01/26 for a period not exceeding eighteen months.
- 3. This Order is required due to the likelihood of danger on both the eastbound and westbound carriageway.
- 4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Officer.
  - (ii) Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
  - (iii) Any vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
